Jean-Marc Brocard's origins lie in the Côte d'Or, the son of a farmer from the village of Chaudenay-le-Château. It was an accident of marriage that brought him to wine, he married a vigneron's daughter. Jean-Marc planted his first vines in 1973 in the village of Préhly, the birth year of his son and now vineyard manager, Julien. Jean-Marc says "The truth of wine lies in the soil where it has grown."
