ABOUT THIS WINERY

Located in the commune of Radda in Chianti, The Poggerino winery is family owned and operated by Piero and Benedetta Lanza, who are descendants of one of Florence's oldest families and they have been managing it since 1988. At Poggerino the focus is on the three Chianti Classico wines, but they also produce a Rosato, Toscano IGT wines and a spumante 100% Sangiovese 'metodo classico' that is aged on the lees for at least 5 years before release.

TASTING NOTES

PRODUCTION NOTES

After having carried out a careful selection of the grapes in the vineyard, de-stemming follows with soft pressing and, without adding selected yeasts, alcoholic fermentation takes place between 28 ° C and 30 ° C. The entire fermentation / maceration process takes place in steel tanks for about 35 days with manual punching down and pumping over. In December the new wine is poured into the 6.5hl concrete egg where the malolactic fermentation takes place. After 12 months of maturation, bottling ...
