First and foremost René Rostaing is a Côte Rôtie Specialist. He is renowned for producing tiny quantities of extraordinarily refined Côte Rôtie wines, which in the words of Robert Parker are "reminiscent of Grand Cru Burgundy in their delicacy, elegance and sublime qualities."

TASTING NOTES

Rostaing's Cuvée 'Ampodium' (formerly named 'Classique') takes its name from the original Roman name for the town of Ampuis where the winery is situated. It is a blend of 13 different parcels, which creates a complex, multifaceted expression of Côte Rôtie. Yields are very low and the wine is aged pr
