#### TASTING NOTES

Complex and intense aromas of black fruits such as blueberries, blackberries, and plums lend great typicity accompanied by a touch of dark chocolate. A wine with tremendous concentration of firm, ripe tannins with a mouth-filling palate and a persistent fruity finish. Enjoy with beef or lamb stew. Also excellent with aged cheeses.

#### PRODUCT NOTES

High-altitude vineyards planted at the foot of the Andes in Chile's most prestigious and emblematic zone for Cabernet Sauvignon.

#### PRODUCTION NOTES

The grapes were fermented in stainless steel tanks for 7 days at 86°F (30°C) followed by a 6-day post-fermentation process. Upon completion of the malolactic fermentation, the wine was aged in French oak barrels for 12 months for greater complexity and structure.
