ABOUT THIS WINERY

The Marion Farm is a small family run property managed by Stefano Campedelli and his wife Nicoletta. The winery and vineyards are in the Marcellise valley, outside the Classico zone, on the hills east of Verona. The soils are predominantly calcareous, farmed sustainably, with minimal intervention in the cellar. Stefano makes Valpolicella reds that are inspired by the wines of Burgundy and Barolo; Elegant, finessed, pure, with low residual sugar.

TASTING NOTES

Ruby red colour with a hint of violet, the bouquet recalls small woodland fruits, cherries, perennial herbs with a hint of spices. A soft, round palate and a complex, persistent taste.

PRODUCTION NOTES

The grapes are harvested between September and October. Part of the grapes are collected in boxes and then placed on plateaux in well-ventilated rooms, where they are partially dried for approx. 40 days. A second part is left hanging on the vines until it reaches super-ripeness, to be harvested, during the first ten days of October, and then pressed. After fermentation the wines obtained are aged separately in oak barrels for about 30 months and lastly blended and bottled.

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
