ABOUT THIS WINERY

Jean-Marc Brocard's origins lie in the Côte d'Or, the son of a farmer from the village of Chaudenay-le-Château. It was an accident of marriage that brought him to wine, he married a vigneron's daughter. Jean-Marc planted his first vines in 1973 in the village of Prêhy, the birth year of his son and now vineyard manager, Julien. Jean-Marc says "The truth of wine lies in the soil where it has grown."

TASTING NOTES

Bright, pale yellow. Good thrust to the aromas of citrus and stone fruits, flowers and menthol. Fatter and denser than the Cote de Joan but with more energy as well. The apple and peach flavors show good depth and persistence.
