Founded in 1781, Vidal-Fleury is the oldest active winery in the Rhone Valley. Located in the heart of the Côte-Rôtie, the winery works with 16 different Appellations d'Origine Contrôlées (AOC), producing wines that are true to the terroir and 'elevage' of their appellations.

The art of patience is a key philosophy of Vidal-Fleury who believe that wine is of course made of grapes, but also with a lot of time.

TASTING NOTES

Appearance : quite a full red, some black highlights

Nose : blackcurrant, spice (nutmeg, pepper), fleeting animal touch.

Palate: strong and elegant tannin, fresh in the middle, touch of oak. Complex and long flavors based on blackcurrant, smoked ham and some black tea.
