ABOUT THIS WINERY

A family-owned business, L'Ecole Nº 41 was founded by Jean and Baker Ferguson. Today, the winery is owned and operated by their daughter and son-in-law, Megan and Martin Clubb. Built in 1915, the schoolhouse is located in historic Frenchtown, a small community just west of Walla Walla, Washington. L'Ecole Nº 41 has been honoured as <i>Wine & Spirits Magazine</i>Vinery of the Year for 14 consecutive years (2002-2015).

TASTING NOTES

Ferguson reflects a unique micro-climate and geological profile. This wine shares its name with the estate vineyard, also called Ferguson. The flavor profile is distinctly influenced by its basalt soil. With complex aromas this wine offers bold dark fruit, espresso, chicory and leather with rich graphite flint and iron minerality. Intricate layers in the mid-palate are buoyed with balanced, natural acidity leading to a robust, persistent finish.
