Vineyards:

Malbec, Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon & Merlot from Gualtallary, Tupungato, 1470 111 / 4,822 ft. High density (10.000 plants per hectare).

Petit Verdot from Agrelo, 930 111 / 3051 ft.

#### PRODUCTION NOTES

Fermentation in barrel, average temperature: 22°C. Cold maceration for 5 days. Average maceration 23 days. 30% whole bunch. French oak barrels 2nd and 3rd use. 5 different harvest times (1,5 months between the first and the last one).
