Identified by the Wine Spectator as 'the best winemaker in the appellation of Brunello di Montalcino', Giancarlo Pacenti took over running his family's 60 hectare estate in 1988. His wines are renowned for their combination of richness and structure. They somehow remain remarkably fresh, pure, and elegant, despite being aged in French oak barriques rather than the large Slovenian oak.

PRODUCT NOTES

Structured and elegant, with silky tannins and a long finish.

This wine comes from two vineyards with vines over 35 years old; annual production is around 30,000 bottles.
