Vincent Cirillo immigrated to South Australia in 1946, with over 400 years of wine making history in the family spanning 9 generations. The Barossa Valley became home in 1842, along with the acquisition of some remarkable vineyards in 1848, some of the first Barossa vines planted. Today, Marco Cirillo, the youngest of Vincent & Lina's four children leads all facets of the Cirillo story, from viticulture to winemaking to winery management.

TASTING NOTES

Bright crimson and cranberry with aromas of dark berry fruits and spices. Medium to full bodied with flavours of cherry, aniseed, and five spice on the palate. Incredible depth and length on the finish.

PRODUCT NOTES

The Cirillo Grenache is more about the variety than the oak. The balance between the primary fruit and the acidity make this a beautifully seamless wine that mimics Rhone styles. One of the few Australian Grenaches that will reward over a decade of cellaring.
