ABOUT THIS WINERY

Vincent Cirillo immigrated to South Australia in 1946, with over 400 years of wine making history in the family spanning 9 generations. The Barossa Valley became home in 1842, along with the acquisition of some remarkable vineyards in 1848, some of the first Barossa vines planted. Today, Marco Cirillo, the youngest of Vincent & Lina's four children leads all facets of the Cirillo story, from viticulture to winemaking to winery management.

TASTING NOTES

Pale green and yellow in colour, with aromas of lifted lemongrass with some clean mineral characters. Fruit is dominant on the palate with a lean, light structure and driven mineral finish.

PRODUCT NOTES

The Cirillo 1850 Semillon is harvested entirely of a single vineyard in the Light Pass region in the Barossa Valley believed to be the oldest Semillon (Madeira) vineyard in the world. It is one of the few remaining Madeira vineyards left in Australia. This is why it is released under the Semillon varietal name, as opposed to the Madeira region.
