ABOUT THIS WINERY

Sokol Blosser is one of the pioneering wineries of the now-prominent Oregon wine industry. The winery is family owned and operated, with the second generation now at the helm: siblings Alex and Alison Sokol Blosser. Today the winery farms 128 acres of vineyards and creates wines of world-class quality, produced in a sustainable manner, which reflect the distinctive flavors of the grapes, soil and climate.

PRODUCTION NOTES

The grapes were carefully hand harvested at a Brix level as low as 21.5°Brix to capture the acidity and as high as 24.5°Brix to emphasize the depth and weight of fruit characters found in this founding section of the Sokol Blosser estate. They were then sorted by hand to remove any flawed bunches and 100% de-stemmed directly into 3-ton stainless steel fermenters. Cap management was done via gentle punch downs up to 2 times per day. 20% of the blend was selected from the ferment that went thro...
