ABOUT THIS WINERY

Sokol Blosser is one of the pioneering wineries of the now-prominent Oregon wine industry. The winery is family owned and operated, with the second generation now at the helm: siblings Alex and Alison Sokol Blosser. Today the winery farms 128 acres of vineyards and creates wines of world-class quality, produced in a sustainable manner, which reflect the distinctive flavors of the grapes, soil and climate.

PRODUCTION NOTES

The grapes were carefully hand harvested at just over 23°Brix on a clear and warm morning in late September. They were then sorted by hand on the crush pad to remove any flawed bunches and 100% de-stemmed directly into several 3-ton stainless steel fermenters. This block was fermented cool and slowly in stainless steel small fermenters. 50% of the fermenters were pressed at dryness with a total of 18 days on the skins. The other 50% was an extended maceration with 44 days on the skins. This win...
