Founded in 1781, Vidal-Fleury is the oldest active winery in the Rhone Valley. Located in the heart of the Côte-Rôtie, the winery works with 16 different Appellations d'Origine Contrôlées (AOC), producing wines that are true to the terroir and 'elevage' of their appellations.

The art of patience is a key philosophy of Vidal-Fleury who believe that wine is of course made of grapes, but also with a lot of time.

TASTING NOTES

Appearance, deep red with some black trace.

Nose complex: grilled meat, pepper, smoky, lightly oaky, tobacco, black fruit.

Palate rich and fresh, silky tannins. Red plum, blackcurrant, spices (peppery, nutmeg), animal flavors on the finish. Good density and long length.
