ABOUT THIS WINERY

Founded in 1781, Vidal-Fleury is the oldest active winery in the Rhone Valley. Located in the heart of the Côte-Rôtie, the winery works with 16 different Appellations d'Origine Contrôlées (AOC), producing wines that are true to the terroir and 'elevage' of their appellations.

The art of patience is a key philosophy of Vidal-Fleury who believe that wine is of course made of grapes, but also with a lot of time.

TASTING NOTES

Appearance deep red with and black trace.

Nose intense : Cassis, pepper, cinnamon, smoky, tobacco, black olive, boxwood.

Palate very round and fresh. Tight tannin, full bodied. Blackcurrant, cherry, spices (peppery, nutmeg), violet, oaky, something animal (dry ham). Unctuous and persistent.
