ABOUT THIS WINERY

Domaine Simon Bize et Fils is a truly classic Burgundian family domain; resolutely old-fashioned (wines typically feature 100% stem inclusion and discrete use of oak), and committed to making age-worthy wines from low-yielding old vines. Located in Savigny-les-Beaune the wines are made by Chisa Bize and, sister-in-law, Marielle Bize-Grivot, who continue the family tradition of authentic, full-flavoured wines of great elegance and finesse.

TASTING NOTES

Vineyard planted in 1993 and 1996 on an eastern-facing slope. The wines display more richness, roundness, and fullness. The soil contains many rocks, as reflected in the neighboring quarries. A small altar resides here. It was constructed by the domaine team, in tribute to the Bize family.
