ABOUT THIS WINERY

Olivier Humbrecht is one of the world's most renowned winegrowers. A Master of Wine who has been described by Robert Parker as the greatest white winemaker on earth. Yet he is very soft spoken, humble, and self-deprecating. He is a champion of terroir, biodynamic farming principles, and non-interventionist winemaking, whose family have been winegrowers in Alsace for 12 generations (since 1620).

TASTING NOTES

This wine is beautifully perfumed with a layer of spicy notes. On the palate, it is silky and med – full bodied. This wine is also dry and refreshing acidity.

PRODUCT NOTES

The respect for the vine and soil is very important for Olivier and his team of vineyard workers. All viticultural work is carried out by hand with the help of some horses to plough the vineyards with minimum impact of the soil. All vineyards have been certified organic and biodynamic since 2002. Low impact farming is practiced, organic composts are used and yields are restricted.

PRODUCTION NOTES

All wines are fermented in traditional oak vats using native yeasts. No additives are used, and chaptalization is never carried out. The wines are left on their lees and ferment at their own pace, the wines are not fined. Very little sulfites are added and the wines are bottled after at least 6 months on the lees.
