Domaine Jean Grivot is one of Burgundy's greatest small family estates. They were one of the first families in Vosne Romanee to bottle and sell their own wine, beginning in the 1930's. The estate has been run by fifth-generation vigneron Etienne Grivot since 1987 with his wife Marielle.

These are classic wines that are quintessentially Burgundian - seductive, serious, and soulful.

TASTING NOTES

The wine shows aromas and flavours of red berries, herbs, and flowers. The palate is rich with ripe fruit and medium bodied with bright acidity and fine tannins. There are also beautiful notes of vanilla, toast, and baking spices.

PRODUCT NOTES

The vineyard of Nuits-Saint-Georges Les Roncière 1er cru lies in the "Zone de Saint-Georges" or central section of Nuits-Saint-Georges near the town itself. Roncière takes its name because the soil is so poor that it is said only "ronces" (mulberries) can grow there. It is produced from a 0.5-hectare parcel from vines planted in 1959.

PRODUCTION NOTES

The grapes are destemmed and cold maceration usually lasts just a day or two. The alcoholic fermentation is spontaneous and malolactic fermentation occurs in barrel. Depending on the vintage, the proportion of new oak is around 30-60% for the premier crus.
