#### ABOUT THIS WINERY

In 2001 Thibault created Domaine Thibault Liger-Belair, which includes two hectares in les Saint-Georges 0.6 hectares of the 4 hectare Grand Cru vineyard of Richebourg, as well as holdings in Clos Vougeot and a collection of well-placed Premier Cru and Villages sites. Recent acquisitions in Moulin à Vent have expanded the domaine into Beaujolais. All are biodynamically farmed; and the attention to detail in the winemaking is second to none.

#### TASTING NOTES

This wine has all about the depth and rich aromas. This appellation, Renardes, known for its very rich with animal, leather and black fruit notes. This wine has a beautiful mixture of floral and fragrant aromas. It is also medium-bodied with fine, earthy tannins at the end.

#### PRODUCT NOTES

This vineyard is 0.3 ha and was planted in 1956. This appellation is located on the mid-slope of the hill of Corton, we consider it one of the most prestigious climates of Corton. These vines are planted on limestone soil on the bottom of the hill and more clay on the top, instead of the rest of the Côte de Beaune. Due to a limestone flaw which is placed on the middle of the plot and which reappears on the lower part of the hillside of Renardes.

#### PRODUCTION NOTES

The grapes are harvested by hand and they are using 40% whole cluster fermentation. There is a 3 week fermentation period with very moderate intervention. They are aging the wine in 60% new French oak barrels for 22 months. The wines are unfiltered and unfined.
