ABOUT THIS WINERY

Pirramimma was founded by Alexander Campbell Johnston in 1892 and has been owned and operated by the Johnston family ever since. The Johnston family arrived in South Australia in 1839, and in 1892 Alexander, the tenth of thirteen children purchased 97 hectares of rich farmland southeast of the then fledgling village of McLaren Vale. He named his land Pirramimma, an Aboriginal phrase meaning "the moon and the stars."

TASTING NOTES

Delicate aromas of rose petal, spicy raspberry and strawberry are delivered on the bouquet. The palate is enveloped with enticing flavours of pomegranate, loganberry, sweet Stella cherry and cranberry complemented by hints of cedar and vanilla oak.

PRODUCT NOTES

This fruit driven Grenache was produced from fruit selected from our old War Horse block planted in 1943.
