ABOUT THIS WINERY

Diamond Creek is a true California legend. Perhaps the greatest attribute of these profoundly special wines is their understatedness, something they have in common with Bordeaux wines such as Haut Brion, Ausone, and Lafite. It is a truism that the very finest wines of California are the wines that are furthest from the big-fruited California stereotype, which these most certainly are. These are precious wines that have tremendous aging potential.

TASTING NOTES

The Volcanic Hill bottling includes a small amount of the extra-ordinary Petit Verdot grape variety. The wine is full bodied and loaded with intense ripe berry fruits, cassis, violets and a smoky richness on the nose and palate, finishing with good length and firm tannins.

PRODUCT NOTES

Volcanic Hill is comprised of 8 acres of south facing hillside vineyard. It is the warmest of all our micro-climates. The color of the soil is gray, and the consistency is that of fluffy, volcanic ash, originally deposited from the eruption of Mt. Konocti 8 million years ago. Volcanic Hill is the longest lived of our wines.
