ABOUT THIS WINERY

Bollinger is a truly classic Champagne house and one of the world's greatest wine producers, renowned for its elegance and refinement.

Founded in 1829 in the village of Ay, by 1884 Bollinger received a Royal Warrant from Queen Victoria. Adding to its prestige, 1979 marked the beginning of one of the longest standing relationships in cinematic history; Bollinger has been the exclusive Champagne of James Bond ever since.

TASTING NOTES

Beautiful aromatic complexity; ripe fruit and spicy aromas with hints of roasted apples, apple compote, peaches, pear, brioche, and fresh walnut. A subtle combination of structure, length and vivacity with bubbles like velvet.

PRODUCT NOTES

The House's 178 hectares are planted with 85% of Grand Cru and Premier Cru vines, spread over seven main vineyards: Aÿ, Avenay, Tauxières, Louvois et Verzenay are planted with Pinot Noir, Cuis with Chardonnay and Champvoisy with Pinot Meunier. Bollinger is one of a very few champagne Houses to produce the majority of their own grapes for their blends.
