ABOUT THIS WINERY

Domaine de Beaurenard has been a family-run estate for seven generations and Daniel and Frederic Coulon have recently been joined by Daniel's sons, Victor and Antonin starting the 8th generation of winegrowers. All the vineyards across the Châteauneuf du Pape, Rasteau and Côtes-du-Rhône are owned by the Coulon family and are certified organic and biodynamic.

TASTING NOTES

An inexhaustible reservoir of mineral elements, Argiles Bleues is a wine of great finesse. A superb marriage of plush, juicy fruit, fine, delicate tannins, and phenomenal minerality.

PRODUCT NOTES

A selection of the best slope and terraced parcels, characterised by a marvellous blue-clay and chalk soil which imparts great depth and minerality to the wine. Varietal mix: 80% Grenache, 20% Syrah.

PRODUCTION NOTES

The grapes are destemmed, lightly crushed and fermented with natural yeast and undergo long vatting in order to fully extract the concentration achieved in the vineyards. Les Argiles Bleues has naturally dense tannins and undergoes maturation in new oak foudres for 15-18 months. This produces concentrated wines of finesse and elegance. The wine is bottled unfiltered at the estate, then stored in our underground cellar at constant temperature.
