In 1956, the founder and his son, Félix Pavone Arbea, officially created Vinos Santa Ema. They have since equipped it with state of the art industrial infrastructure to develop and manage wines of the highest quality.

#### TASTING NOTES

Intense fruit aromas with notes of plums and blackberries accompanied by intense and unmistakable notes of caramel, vanilla, and chocolate. Smooth, with ripe tannins, good structure, and very good balance. Pairs excellently with red and white meats, pastas, game birds, and cheeses.

#### PRODUCT NOTES

The vineyards of Santa Ema are planted along the banks of the Maipo River, where the terroir manifests all of its expression in one of Chile's oldest and most classic wine regions. The wines from this vintage will be remembered for their tremendous complexity, volume, and well-rounded texture.

#### PRODUCTION NOTES

The grapes were crushed and fermented in stainless steel tanks for 7 days at 86°F (30°C) followed by another 6 days of post-fermentation macerations. Upon completion of the malolactic fermentation, the wine was barrel aged for 8–10 months in French and American oak to obtain and deliver greater complexity and structure.
