Why Matchbook? As a farm kid growing up in the late 1950's and early 1960's John Giguiere was a confirmed pyromaniac starting various things on fire such as his father's wheat field. He eventually grew out of this fascination with the "Matchbook" but still have fond memories of its power.

TASTING NOTES

Petite Sirah grown in the Dunnigan Hills produces the full-bodied, well-structured wine expected from this distinct varietal. This deeply colored red wine delivers on the aromatics: lots of fresh fruit and pepper spice. The flavors are an intense mix of raspberry preserve, violets, rhubarb and char. The finish has a refined vanilla note from oak aging and a juiciness that begs for another sip.
