Piquant, on-point, guava. The Kris' recognizable green hand label was designed by Italian artist Riccardo Schweizer (1925-2004). Consistently on-point it offers guava, lemondrops, honey, white peach and acacia on the nose. It is tangy and lengthy, with lovely viscosity and piquant citrus flavours, which are rounded out with distinct mineral notes. Pair: A rustic antipasti platter, a simple Aglio e Olio (pasta with garlic, olive oil and chili flakes) or white meats.
