


GRGICH HILLS

Fumé Blanc, Sauvignon Blanc 2011

Farmed under Biodynamics at Grgich's American Canyon and Carneros estate vineyards, this wine has the intensity of flavor that fruit can give at the peak of ripeness. The depth of that fruit flavor ranges from tart pear skin to kumquat, both brisk and resonant. Its underlying earthiness parallels the structure of a classic Loire chenin; a sauvignon that's refreshing with river fish and big enough for foie gras.
