Muscular, classic, slick. This wine is muscular, it has the posture of a red wine. There is a classic Alsatian Pinot Gris earthy/mushroomy character to this version, notes which are woven with golden fruits and quince paste. Slick in texture, it has notable weight and a very long tangy and citrusy finish to keep it bright and not brooding.



What is a wine score and how do wine reviewers (I don't refer to myself as a wine critic, I review wine, I don't criticize it) decide on that score? A wine score is a numerical rating wine reviewers give to a wine based on a series of elements. Every wine reviewer (or wine critic) has their own method of getting to a conclusive number even if they use similar guidelines to one another.
