Grand Mère is only the entry point Pinot Noir from Roy Urvieta, but it's still delightful stuff that would give a lot of red Burgundies a run for their euros. Clones 115 and 667 are used here, with 20% whole cluster fermentation and 10% new wood. Juicy, floral and succulent, it's layered, spicy and sweetly fruited.
