“Broad, succulent, concentrated. Great packaging. A well-designed burnt label is perfectly suited to this Matchbook Syrah, which adds 8% Cabernet Sauvignon to broaden its flavour profile. It is flush with blackberry, black raspberry, vanilla, smoked plum and sarsaparilla alongside rich mocha, sunbaked earth and savoury layers. The palate is supple with generous sweet briary fruit, chocolaty/mocha and peppery spices. Expect very good concentration and length. Pair: Roasted meats, hard cheeses, spicy sausage and almost anything you can grill.”

About Wine Scores

What is a wine score and how do wine reviewers (I don't refer to myself as a wine critic, I review wine, I don't criticize it) decide on that score? A wine score is a numerical rating wine reviewers give to a wine based on a series of elements. Every wine reviewer (or wine critic) has their own method of getting to a conclusive number even if they use similar guidelines to one another.
