"Despite the heat of eastern Mendoza, which usually produces heavy flavors and high alcohol, this is a fresh and vibrant red full of tension. Thanks to early harvests, it has firm acidity that helps the fruit express itself in a much juicier and livelier way. This bonarda was fermented in clay amphorae and then aged in them for eight months before being bottled."



Descorchados is the main reference for South American wines.
