elegant array of lilac, lavender, lemon rind and green apple scents displays a wisp of exotic spiced tea. Much like the palate

impression of the Charmes, the unusually rich and voluminous medium weight flavors completely coat the palate with sappy dry extract which again buffers the firm acid backbone on the focused, complex and beautifully persistent finish where a hint of

bitter lemon arises. This is at once lacy and refined yet powerful while also remaining extremely promising - it should amply

repay a decade plus of cellaring.
