Weighty, slick, harmonious. I've reviewed this wine a couple of times and I think it's such a wonderful alternative white with incredible personality. Golden in colour and aromas of lanolin, mineral, beeswax and straw flowers, yellow apples, Meyer lemons and just a hint of herbs. It is weighty and tangy, slick in texture and with excellent concentration. It is harmonious and juicy with a long and clean finish.
