A cooler nose offers more slightly obvious Chablis typicity on the citrus, acacia blossom and white orchard fruit aromas. The crisp, intense and well-detailed middle weight flavors exude a fine bead of minerality before concluding in a relatively dry, persistent and lingering finish. I wouldn't describe this as classic in style but certainly more so than the Petit Chablis.
