Some of the vines here are over 70 years old. Even with a reticent, understated nose one can sense the energy and precision in this wine. There's a lovely, creamy texture on the palate, with bright citrus notes and a long, lingering, savoury, mineral finish. A very fine example of Chablis which would compete very effectively against many a premier cru.
